

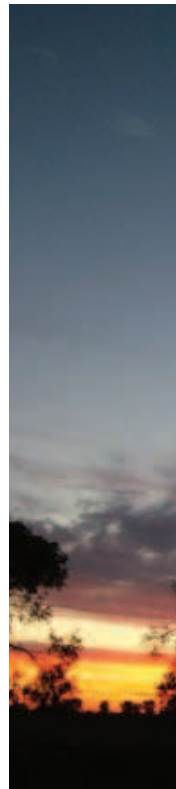


BIRD TRAILS of the WAMBO SHIRE

Approximately 122km Mostly Gravel Roads - Can be slippery when wet - Look out for cattle and wildlife. GPS Datum is WGS 84

HABITAT: Open grassland, Cultivation, Softwood scrub, Brigalow, Eucalypts, Interesting dams.

BIRDS: Pink-eared and Blue-billed Ducks, Plumed Whistling Duck, Fairy Martin. Various raptors.

The Dingo Fence, the longest man-made structure in the world starts here. Only major sites are marked.
